Organization Description

Centro Tyrone Guzman is a multi-service non-profit organization serving low-income Latine families in Minnesota. Our youth programs work with Latine teens to achieve academic, social, and economic success by identifying and removing the barriers they experience, in a nurturing and culturally responsive environment. Centro Tyrone Guzman's Education department includes Siembra Montessori, Be@school and Raices programs.

Responsibilities

- 1) Implement youth projects and activities as assigned
- 2) Plan lessons, conduct outreach activities, help with logistics of presentations and guest speakers, and outings
- 3) Facilitate or co-facilitate small group sessions with youth at Centro Tyrone Guzman and/or partner schools
- 4) Provide transportation for youth participants as needed
- 5) Provide positive behavior guidance for program participants
- 6) Assist youth participants in setting personal goals in the areas of education, health/wellness, personal and cultural development, and community involvement
- 7) Keep accurate, up-to-date records
- 8) Maintain positive communication with parents/families
- 9) Maintain constructive working relationships with schools and community partners
- 10) Assist in facilitating family engagement projects and events
- 11) Maintain a clean, safe classroom environment
- 12) Maintain a supportive, inclusive and culturally-responsive social environment
- 13) Ensure programming complies with local, state and national regulations
- 14) Participate in professional development activities as assigned
- 15) Other duties and responsibilities as assigned

Skills, Qualifications and Requirements

Qualified candidates will:

- Have some college. Coursework in Education, Social Work, Youth Development or related fields
- Be bilingual / bicultural (English and Spanish)
- Have in-depth understanding of, and appreciation for Latine cultures
- Be able to work evenings during the academic year and day-time hours during the summer
- Be able to work weekends, on occasion, for special events
